Mission

Our mission is to feed Southwest Virginia's hungry through a network of partners and engage our region in the fight to end hunger.

Service Area

Feeding America Southwest Virginia serves 26 counties and their associated municipalities in Southwestern Virginia. This comprises 12,400 square miles (approx. total land area of Massachusetts and Connecticut combined).

Salem Distribution Center (98,090 square foot facility)

Counties: Alleghany, Bedford, Botetourt, Craig, Floyd, Franklin, Giles, Henry, Montgomery, Patrick, Pittsylvania, Pulaski, Roanoke
